



PREPARING FOR YOUR PHOTOSHOOT

We've compiled the list below to help our clients prepare their homes for photoshoots. Following this easy checklist will help you make your home as marketable as possible!

INTERIOR

- Turn all the lights on and replace burnt out bulbs.
- Twist open the blinds and pull back any curtains.
- Make sure all surface areas are clean and without clutter.
- Lower all toilet seats, clear bathroom counters, and remove toiletries from shower.
- Remove magnets and personal photos from fridge and other areas.
- Secure pets before shoot, and remove all pet supplies from view.

EXTERIOR

- Turn all exterior lights on and replace burnt out bulbs.
- Ensure no vehicles are in driveway or on street in front of the home.
- Close garage doors and backyard fences.
- Give your neighbors a friendly heads up so they can also clean up their yards.
- Store all gardening equipment, hoses, and tools away from view.
- Mow the lawn, pull weeds, and tidy both front and backyards.
